
Behind Mr. Bunyan by Agnes Beaumont (YOUTH BIO BEA). A twenty-one year old girl with a hunger to learn the Word of God begins to attend John Bunyan's church, and finds her spiritual life deepening. Yet at the same time, she faces opposition even within her own family to attending worship there, as evil rumours spread about Bunyan and eventually about herself as well. Listen in, as Agnes tells, in her own words, the story of her growing faith and readiness to take a stand for Christ, though it may cost her everything else she counts precious and of God's kindness in delivering her from false accusation and opposition.

Imprisoned – *From the Life of Huguenot Marie Durand-Serres* by Lenie Ippel-Breedveld (YOUTH BIO IPP). Imprisoned for 38 years ... 250 years ago this is what happened to Marie Durand, simply because she was a Huguenot. Marie's mother dies while in prison, her father was imprisoned for more than fourteen years, and her brother Pierre, a well-known Huguenot preacher was hanged. For 38 years, Marie Durand herself was held captive near the Rhine River in the Tower of Steadfastness, together with other women. While being held in this tower, Marie Durand was a blessing to others; she cared for the sick, comforted grieving ones, and encouraged those in despair. Imprisoned is a moving story about a young Huguenot, based on historical facts.

Five Pioneer Missionaries by David Brainerd, William C. Burns, John Eliot, Henry Martyn & John G. Paton (266 BRA). There are few more thrilling periods of church history than the great missionary movement which stretched from the eighteenth into the nineteenth century. Recognising that Jesus Christ was the missionary sent by the Father, and that the Bible is the Magna Carta of missions, men like Henry Martyn, John G. Paton, John Eliot, David Brainerd and William Chalmers Burns left home, family and love for the sake of Christ glorified in the salvation of the nations make awe-inspiring and God-honouring reading. Five Pioneer Missionaries tells the story of each of these servants of God. In doing so it not only outlines some of the great biblical principles of missions, but also challenges Christians today to live lives completely dedicated to serving Jesus Christ wherever He calls us to go.
